### For those hosting PGCE Primary with QTS (Part Time and Full Time) - Serial Days

Our PGCE trainees are now in their final serial days before their block placement commences after half term. They should now have invited their mentor to view their Abyasa timeline and initial training meetings (ITMs) with their Link Tutor should have either taken place or be planned to occur soon. Trainees should have shared their teaching requirements for the first weeks back with their CBM and have agreed which lessons they will plan and deliver. They should be using the St Mary's lesson plan template for all their teaching and share their planning with their CBM at least 48 working hours before they teach the lesson. Please also identify which of their four lessons will be formally observed for the first week back. We would recommend that this is not the first one they teach to the class.

#### Weekly Curriculum Foci and Tasks

The weekly foci for these days continue to revolve around setting high expectations and managing behaviour. These foci are supported by the training plan by encouraging trainees to engage in classroom based activities such as taking the register and reading to the class, as well as seeking opportunities to observe expert colleagues with a focus on these areas of their practice. Trainees should now have identified their profile children and be contributing to your classroom environment by supporting their CBM and working more closely with the children.
