## For those hosting PGCE Primary with QTS (Part Time and Full Time) - Week 4 Block Placement

Teaching Expectations: This week sees trainees plan and deliver 2 consecutive maths, 2 consecutive English, 1 PE and 1 science lesson. They will greatly appreciate your support with planning and informal feedback after their lessons. Only one of these lessons needs to be formally observed.

Weekly Curriculum Foci and Research: This week's foci centre around professional behaviours and the responsibilities of a teacher in promoting progress for all pupils. As such, the documentation that underpins this week's practice is the Equality Act (2010), with a focus on how this can be enacted through our work in school with children and their families. ## For those hosting Year 1 BA Primary Education with QTS - Serial Days

**Serial Day Expectations:** There are no teaching expectations for our Year 1 trainees during their serial days. They will spend their four weeks of serial days working alongside their mentor to establish their role in the classroom, observe expert colleagues and build relationships with the children in their class. During the serial days, an initial training meeting with the St Mary's Link Tutor will take place to support you in working with our trainees.

Weekly Curriculum Foci: Our trainees begin their time in school focusing on setting high expectations and managing behaviour as they begin to establish their classroom presence. Your support in discussing this with them over the course of their first days in school is much appreciated. Please refer to the training plan for more details.
