Week 1: 2nd to 6th October

This week's theme relates to planning for learning by considering factors such as how to avoid overloading working memory and how to plan effective lessons. Our research link for this week uses the work of Rosenshine (2012) by prompting trainees to consider the value of strategies like modelling and scaffolding. In discussion with their mentor, they are encouraged to explore approaches to learning within your school and how these will shape their planning and delivery of lessons. Other tasks for this week include observing expert colleagues to consider how learning is promoted and the retention of new information is supported, which will inform how our trainees apply these strategies to their practice when teaching their own lessons. In addition, trainees should be beginning to explore the concepts of cognition, formative assessment and promoting behaviour for learning in their practice as these formed part of their University based input prior to their school experience. As such, we also attach a recent publication considering 'The Value of Using Tests in Education as Tools for Learning – Not Just for Assessment', which has also been shared with our trainees.
