#### Week 4: 30th October to 3rd November

This week's theme draws upon the Education Endowment Fund's (EEF) key findings relating to the use and impact of <u>Individualised instruction</u> to tailor to the different needs of learners. The EEF outline some of the opportunities and challenges of this approach and how it may be implemented in practice. Trainees should observe how expert colleagues provide opportunities to practice and use retrieval tasks that enable pupils to attempt more challenging work and should considered how they might use exposition to facilitate these opportunities in the lessons they plan and teach.
