Week 2: 15th to 19th January

Weekly theme: The foci for this week centre around developing key aspects of teaching, including making marking manageable and building positive working relationships in the school environment. Trainees will be asked to engage in professional conversations with their mentors about how to address these areas of their practice using the prompts provided in the training plan, which is linked below. This will also include access and engagement with the assessment policy as well as a pupil pursuit and observations of expert colleagues.

Research: Our research focus for this week is based on the EEF's report entitled 'Working with parents to support children's learning' and prompts the trainees to discuss with their mentors how to make dialogue around learning positive and with clear outcomes for the learner. More detail can be found in the training plan, which will support trainees in applying the theory covered to their developing practice.
