## Week 5: 5th to 9th February

Weekly theme: The focus for this week is a consideration of how teachers communicate belief in all learners thereby motivating pupils and building trusting relationships with their cohort. Trainees will engage with this focus through discussion with their mentor, a consideration of school ethos and observing how expert colleagues employ a range of strategies to motivate the pupils they teach. Trainees are also asked to highlight their own strategies in their planning, including the challenges they set and how they will present these to pupils.

Research: Tsiplakides and Keramida (2010) explore the impact of teacher expectations and labelling on pupil outcomes. In discussion with their mentor, trainees should reflect on how this research applies to their professional practice and their observations of teaching and learning at this point in their training. Please refer to the research and literature summary to support you in facilitating this dialogue.
