Week 3: 15th to 19th April

Weekly theme: The focus for this week is a consideration of how to promote literacy across the curriculum. Trainees should reflect on how all teachers are responsible for the development of literacy regardless of their subject specialism. They should make use of observations and discussion with expert colleagues to support this. Mentors can support their trainees by taking the time to engage in professional reflection with their trainee and explaining different strategies and approaches to support trainee understanding.

Research focus: This week's research focus is provided by EEF (2021) Improving Literacy in Secondary Schools, a summary of which can be found here.

SMART Target Setting

Monitoring of Subject Knowledge

Secure subject knowledge is another important aspect of trainee development. The weekly target focusing on subject knowledge allows for ongoing reflection on a trainee's confident delivery of the curriculum. Please do discuss this with your trainee in your weekly training meetings and your link tutor in your regular communication with them. We appreciate mentors raising any areas that you feel would benefit from further development and/or exploration to promote trainee progress.
