- 1. To oversee and assess the implementation of the University's Research Strategy, providing appropriate supportive mechanisms.
- 2. To recommend the approval of the establishment of University Research Centres and to monitor their performance
- 3. Through the REF Group, to be responsible for the University's submission to assessments of research quality, notably REF2021.

- 4. To drive the strategy and related actions for the University's application for Research Degree Awarding Powers (RDAP). Post-RDAP, through the Research Student Sub-Committee/Research Degrees Committee* to oversee the progression and completion of doctoral students.
- 5. To identify key research and REF activities requiring central funding and to be responsible for such funding.
- 6. To shape and implement the central University's REF sabbatical scheme.
- 7. To support and monitor applications for external research funding. To ensure that successful grant awards are delivered and they are compliant with the funder requirements.
- 8. To proactively seek opportunities to increase PGR student numbers and to approve University funded studentships, as appropriate.
- 9. Through the Ethics Sub-Committee, to ensure compliance with the University's ethical guidelines for research and keep those guidelines under review.
- 10. To promote equality and diversity within the remit of the Committee.
- 11. To consider any other matters referred to the University Research Committee
- 12. To report to appropriate senior committees of the University.
